



## **Number Lines**

For Count back 1, 2 & 3 Difference of 1, 2 & 3 Activities to 20 (to 13)




find the 2 numbers on the number line and find the "difference between them.

- At the start your students may need to count touching the number lines.
- Use the flash cards and have the students recall answers for them.
- Ask your students to identify the answer or flash card for stories. "I saw 7 frogs. 2 hopped away. There are 5 frogs left.
- Extend stories to match related facts (7–2=5; 7–5=2, 5+2=7, 2+5=7). Do this gradually. Don't rush your students to make these connections.
- Encourage your students to see the number lines in their heads and just "know" the answers.
