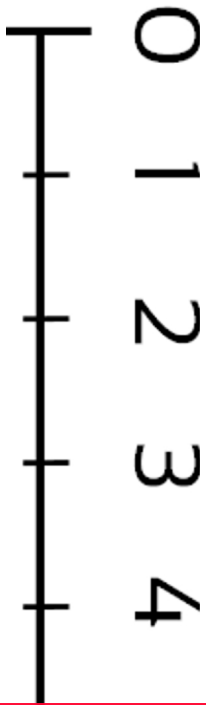

find the 2 numbers on the number line and find the "difference between them.

- At the start your students may need to count touching the number lines.
- Use the flash cards and have the students recall answers for them.
- Ask your students to identify the answer or flash card for stories. "I saw 7 frogs. 2 hopped away. There are 5 frogs left.
- Extend stories to match related facts ($7-2=5$; $7-5=2$, $5+2=7$, $2+5=7$). Do this gradually. Don't rush your students to make these connections.
- Encourage your students to see the number lines in their heads and just "know" the answers.



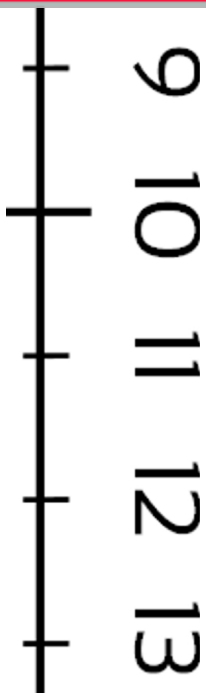
