Print the black line masters onto a light colored cardboard. Use color printing if possible. Then carefully cut the cards out along the lines.


As there are 2 different sets of dominoes, it is advisable to print the different sets on slightly differently colored card (e.g. pale blue/white) so that the packs do not get mixed up or can be resorted easily).


Domino rules

8.	Should all the dominoes from the pick up pile be gone and no-one ca	an go

- 8. Should all the dominoes from the pick up pile be gone and no-one can go then the game is "blocked" and the player with the least number of dominoes wins. Should some of the players have the same number of dominoes, then they should turn over all their remaining dominoes. The player with smallest number of dots/ numbers is the winner.
- 9. The pattern created should look similar the one below. The domino chain can snake its way around the table. Doubles are usually laid sideways across the end domino as shown by the double 9.
