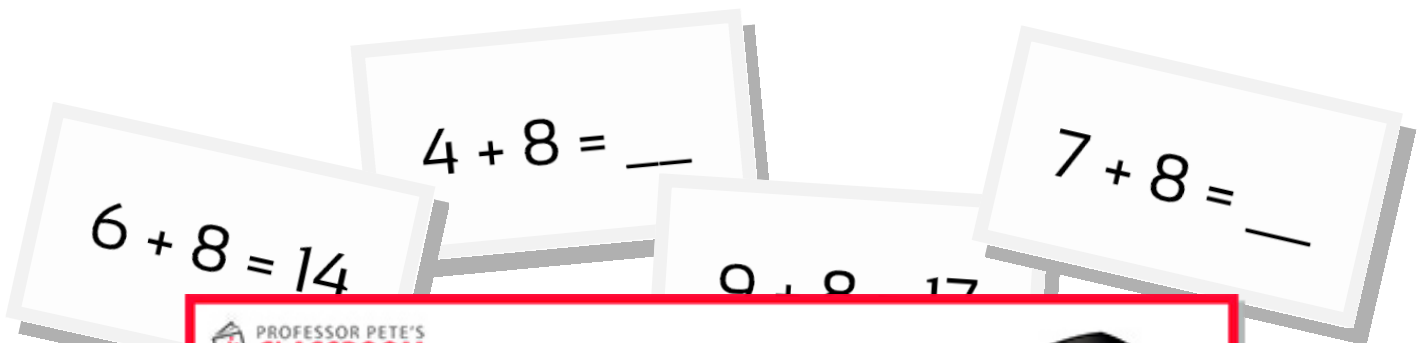


# Addition Flash Cards

## Near Ten + 8 (cards A5 size)



### Addition

Print and cut out each card for use in a second or third year classroom.

### Flashcard

- Have a student give a related addition fact.
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact.
- Have a student give a related addition fact.
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact.
- Have a student give a related addition fact.
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact.

### Flashcards without answers:

- Have all students say each number fact as it is shown, **adding** the answer.
- Have individual students respond with the answer. Make it a speed test. If students are hesitant, relate question to the + 10 fact. "5 + 10 is 15 so 5 + 8 is 13"
- Have two or three students race to be the first to respond with the correct answer.
- Have a student say the "turn around" fact.
  - ◊ e.g. [5 + 8 = 13] turn around fact: "8 + 5 = 13"
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact.
  - ◊ e.g. [13 - 8 = 5] or "13 - 5 = 8"
- Tell stories about the addition fact e.g. "One child had 2 marbles. Another child had 8 marbles. How many marbles were there altogether?" "A farmer planted 6 bushes and then planted another 8. How many bushes were planted altogether?"



This is a

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$$0 + 8 = 8$$

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$$1 + 8 = 9$$

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

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$$3 + 8 = 11$$
