

## Resources:

- 3D solid objects that can be washed (plastic is probably best)
- paint
- roller or brush
- paper for each student

## Object of activity:

- For students to explore 3D objects and be able to identify geometric features such as the number and shape of faces

## Activity:

- Students paint the faces of different shapes and print them onto a sheet of paper.
- This can be used for a variety of experiments.
- May be used to identify 3D objects.
- Remember to label which faces are which.
- Discuss the results of the experiment (why are some faces rectangular and some are circular?)


