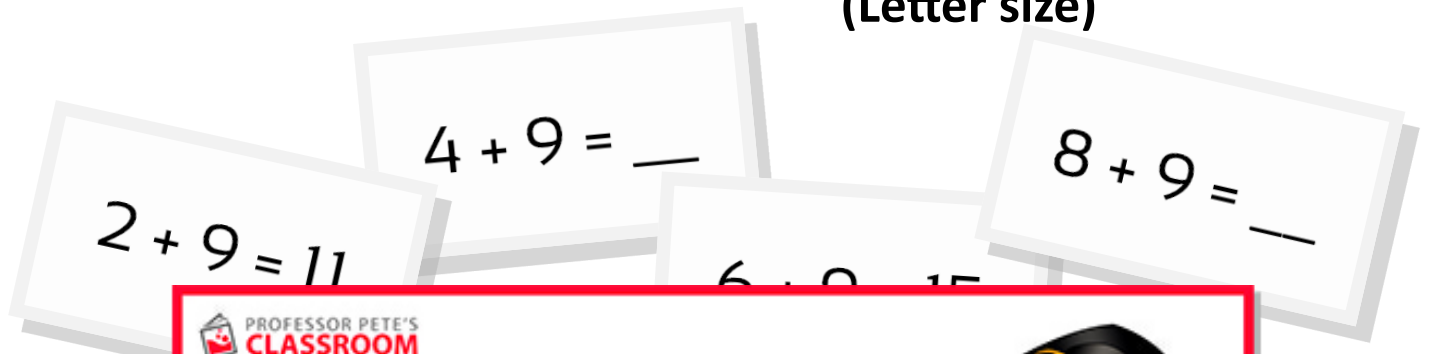


Addition Flash Cards

Near Ten + 9

(Letter size)



Addition

Print and cut out each card for a flashcard.

Flashcards

- Have a student give an addition fact
- Relate the addition fact to a subtraction fact
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact
 - ◇ e.g. [8 + 9 = 17] related subtraction fact: "17 - 9 = 8"
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact
 - ◇ e.g. "17 - 9 = 8" or "17 - 8 = 9"

Flashcards without answers:

- Have all students say each number fact as it is shown, **adding** the answer.
- Have individual students respond with the answer. Make it a speed test. If students are hesitant, relate question to the + 10 fact. "8 + 10 is 18 so 8 + 9 is 17"
- Have two or three students race to be the first to respond with the correct answer.
- Have a student say the "turn around" fact
 - ◇ e.g. [8 + 9 = 17] turn around fact: "9 + 8 = 17"
- Have a student give a related subtraction fact
 - ◇ e.g. "17 - 9 = 8" or "17 - 8 = 9"
- Tell stories about the addition fact e.g. "One child had 2 marbles. Another child had 9 marbles. How many marbles were there altogether?"
